**WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES**

After the closing date, DDTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 10 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries including wait listed entries must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **the closing date**. Any entries withdrawn prior to 6:00 PM, July 2, 2018, will be replaced by a wait list entry. Refunds, minus processing fee, will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. See **"Refunds" for refund policy**. **HEIGHT DIVISIONS**

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

**COURSE FAMILIARIZATION**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

### OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. M.A.D. Agility's equipment is within all specs to AKC requirements. Weave poles are 24" spaced and contacts rubberized. Ring sizes will be 80' x 110' for all 2 rings.

### **EXHIBITOR INFORMATION**

#### **SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. DDTC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. DDTC reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the DDTC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

**DDTC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

### **ENTRY ELIGIBILITY**

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

### **MOVE UPS**

Per American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title. Before the trial, move-ups may be made prior to the move-up deadline via email to [trialsec@bvtrainingcenter.com](mailto:trialsec@bvtrainingcenter.com) or USPS in writing to Robert Kripaitis at 730 Mt Airy Rd, Lewisberry, PA 17339. Verbal move-ups will not be accepted. Move-ups are due in writing by Monday, July 2, 2018 at 6pm.

Day-to-Day Move-ups are only allowed for dogs entered at the set of back-to-back agility trials for succeeding days of that set of back-to-back agility trials. Move-ups must be submitted in writing at the trial within 15 minutes of the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and cannot be conveyed via fax, email, phone or verbally. They must be given to Trial Secretary. Forms will be available in the MOVE-UP BOOK that will be located near score postings.

### **REFUNDS**

No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the action of the event committee.

**Refunds for Bitches in Season / injured dogs/ injured handlers: A refund of entries minus a DDTC service fee of \$10.00 / dog/ day for bitches in season or injured dogs will be granted when a veterinarian's letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> trial day dog is entered. Must use official Veterinary's Letter Head. Official Doctor's Letter Head must be used in the case of an injured handler.**

### **Leashes**

All dogs must be on leash at the trial. Retractable leashes are not allowed in the building. Dogs may only be off leash while running the course or at the practice jump.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
